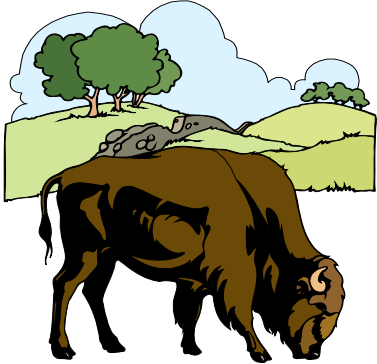

We will continue to support His Way Ministries both financially and with our prayers.
